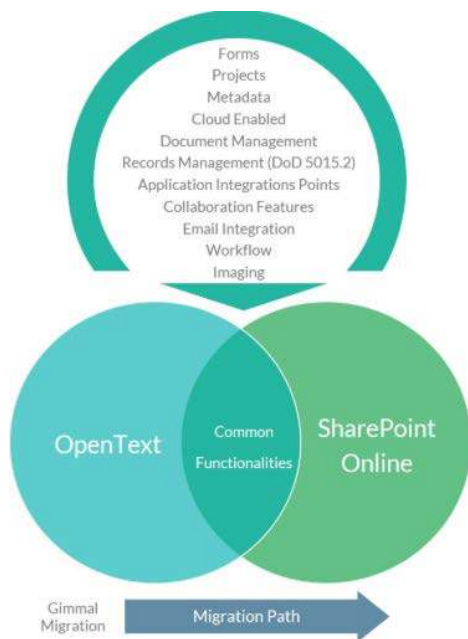


Comparison of Common Livelink to SharePoint Migration Requirements

Key Requirement or Feature	Our Competitors	Gimmel Migrate
Support detailed configuration and migration of content, metadata, and permissions	✓	✓
Support configuration and migration of records management metadata	✗	✓
Supports Livelink 9.7.1, Content Server 10 and 10.5 as source, and SharePoint 2010 and 2013 on or off premise as destination	✗	✓
Support Network Drive as destination with full metadata and paths preserved	✗	✓
Provides analysis tool to identify potential problems prior to migration	✗	✓
Does not require complex Livelink server side module installs	✗ (depends)	✓
